Information/Discussion Items 3.

a) Budget

- Mr. McKenzie did an overview of the budget both the revenues and expenditures
- \blacktriangleright the necessity of the cuts was outlined
- > the general areas where money would be saved was outlined

b) Audit Committee

- > its purpose and make up were reviewed
- > the context of the committee relative to the outside auditors and the regional auditors was explained
- > a brief discussion about risk management took place

c) Update on St. Christopher and St. Patrick - Paul Wubben, Director of Education

- \blacktriangleright the hope is that funding will be forthcoming in the late spring or early fall the business case will put us in good stead with the Ministry
- > it was noted that even in this best case scenario the 2013 date would not be possible
- there were questions and discussion around the issue of the Sarnia Secondary schools losing enrolment
- > it was noted that the subject has been discussed, the magnet program has expanded, the schools will be staffed together
- > issue re: sports have come to the attention of the Director and discussions are ongoing with LKDSB

d) FACE Breakfast

- ▶ three MPPs, the Mayor of C-K, and two C-K councillors were present it was noted that all Mayors and Wardens had been invited
- students from the three secondary schools did presentations outlining the contribution that Catholic education had made in our communities

e) ICE

- Catholic Education partners were together for two days
- > the subject of the discussion was the past, present and the next 25 years of Catholic Education
