Brenda Courey opened the meeting at 7:03 p.m.

1. Opening Prayer

B. Courey – Assistant Superintendent

The meeting began with an opening prayer led by Brenda Courey.

2. Review of Agenda

B. Courey – Assistant Superintendent

Brenda Courey reviewed the agenda with all in attendance.

3. Approval of Meeting Notes from October 14, 2014

Tom Moore motioned to approve the meeting notes as presented. The motion was seconded by Ed Freeburn. All attendees were in favour. Motion accepted.

4. School Year Calendar

A. Sutton – Superintendent

- Ann Sutton distributed copies of the draft school year calendar to all in attendance.
- She explained that the Ministry outlines how many days are required in the school year as instructional days, along with 6 Professional Development Days.
- She highlighted 3 potential issues that were encountered: Starting school before Labour Day, early Easter, having second semester for high school students start on a Friday (to have enough days in the semester).
- The parents discussed the calendar in groups, and then provided feedback.

5. Catholic Trustee's Survey

C. Bryden – Chair of the Board

- Carol Bryden passed out a copy of the Trustees survey "The Role of the Catholic School Trustee". Parents and staff in attendance were asked to complete the survey. It is voluntary and anonymous.
- Mrs. Bryden explained the purpose of the survey is to assist the Trustees in improving their communication to staff and the community.

6. Mental Health Plan

C. Preece – Mental Health Lead

- Christine Preece explained new language around Mental Health. The term Health & Well-being brings a positive perspective, and the focus is on well-being.
- The current focus is on how to help the "whole child"
- Parents were shown a video: Bell Let's Talk Video Howie Mandel (youtube.com)
- Mrs. Preece explained that caring adults are the number one important thing. She commented that a caring adult is lacking in most children who develop mental health issues.
- Parents were shown another video: System Change in Newfoundland and Labrador (youtube.com)
- It was explained that we need a 'system change' and this is what we are working towards. Christine discussed components of this in our board and what is in place already.
- A third video was shown: Bell Let's Talk Video Changing Language (youtube.com)
- A website is in the development phase. We will have a well-being website on our internal and external website in the near future.
