5. FACE Team Update

Laura Callaghan provided an update. Highlights included:

- Brief update more info to come next meeting
- A major focus currently is ensuring that all school boards are able speak intelligently and consistently if asked about the possibility of a one-board school system in Ontario
- This focus has been heavily emphasized by Bishop Fabbro
- Another focus is educating local MPPs on the uniques benefits of Catholic Education; to this end, principals are being asked to communicate with T. Lozon regarding any school event that gain the attention/participation of relevant MPPs
- To help communicate the special benefits of Catholic education principals in particular are being asked to contact T. Lozon if there is a school event that may be of interest to local MPPS
- A further focus is promoting <u>www.togetherinfaith.ca</u>; all staff are encouraged to visit the site, sign up for notifications and make use of #togetherinfaith
