- Ray Power Principal of the Year, Catholic Principals' Council of Ontario
- Deb Crawford Vice President, Ontario Catholic Supervisory Officers' Association
- Linda Ward Regional Director, Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association

Brief summaries of the noted recent achievements for Ray Power, Deb Crawford and Linda Ward follow.

Ray Power - Principal, Ursuline College

Ursuline College Principal Ray Power has been honoured as CPCO's 2015 Principal of the Year. The award is given annually for outstanding school and community leadership. Ray has served on CPCO committees since 2007. In September 2010 he accepted a position on the Council of District Representatives. From 2011 to 2013 he served on the Minister's Principal Reference Group and was President of St. Clair CPCO from 2012 to 2014. He currently serves as Past-President on the Executive. Ray was also recognized for his work in Special Education, Safe and Inclusive Schools and serving at-risk students.

Deb Crawford – Superintendent of Education

Superintendent of Education Deb Crawford has been acclaimed to the position of Vice President of the Ontario Catholic Supervisory Officers' Association (OCSOA), which is dedicated to furthering the interests of Catholic education and promoting the professional development and welfare of its members. In this role, Deb will be called on to work with her OCSOA colleagues to promote and celebrate Catholic education. She will work with the executive team to build partnerships locally, provincially, nationally and internationally to ensure representation of OCSOA at consultations and committees in order to serve Catholic education and support the role of Catholic system leaders.

Linda Ward -- Trustee

Trustee Linda Ward has been acclaimed to the position of Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association (OCSTA) Director for Region 5, a position she has held since 2007. Linda has been a Catholic Trustee since 1991 and has served on various regional and provincial committees, including Legislation and Finance, Office Management, Catholic Education, Conference and Labour Relations. Linda has also served on the Minister's Advisory Committee for Special Education and is a regular participant in the Queen's Park Lobby Days. She currently serves as OCSTA's representative to the Catholic Education Foundation of Ontario.
