Re: Immunization Records of Children in JK to Grade 8

According to the Immunization of School Pupils Act (ISPA), public health units are required to have a student's complete record of immunization, or an exemption for the following communicable diseases:

- Diphtheria
- Tetanus
- Polio
- Varicella (chicken pox) for school students born in 2010 or later.
- Measles, mumps, rubella
- Meningococcal disease
- Pertussis (whooping cough)

These vaccines, and the timing between the immunizations of the vaccines, are important to keep your child protected from disease outbreaks that can happen in schools.

If you have received a notice from Lambton Public Health, this could mean your child is in need of a vaccine or we have not been informed that your child has received a vaccine.

When your child receives an immunization, please report the child's name, date of birth, which vaccine was received and the exact date it was received to Lambton Public Health.
