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BOARD OF TRUSTEES AWARDS PROJECT CONTRACTS

St. Clair Catholic's Board of Trustees has awarded contracts for four projects at schools in Chatham-Kent and Sarnia-Lambton.

Two of the projects are funded through the School Condition Improvement Program, to address school renewal priorities of the Board:

- Bullock & Sons Roofing was the low bidder for a roof replacement project at St. John Fisher Catholic School in Forest.
Total Project Cost – \$358,635
- Rauth Roofing Limited was the low bidder for a roof replacement project at Ursuline College in Chatham.
Total Project Cost – \$381,725

The two remaining projects are funded through an allocation to address capital needs related to the implementation of Year 3 Full Day Kindergarten. Both projects also include upgrades to the HVAC systems, which will be funded through the Board's regular renewal allocation.

- Front Construction Industries Inc. was the low bidder for the Full Day Kindergarten retrofit and HVAC upgrades at St. Joseph Catholic School in Tilbury.
Total Project Cost – \$1,064,223
- Westhoek Construction Ltd. was the low bidder for the Full Day Kindergarten retrofit and HVAC upgrades at Christ The King Catholic School in Wallaceburg. There will also be renovations necessary to meet licensing requirements for a child care program, which is being partially funded through a contribution from the Municipality of Chatham-Kent.
Total Project Cost – \$445,646

The work will be completed over the summer months.
