### ***EARTH RANGERS BRING STUDENTS MESSAGE OF THE IMPORTANCE OF BIO-DIVERSITY IN THE ENVIRONMENT***

The Earth Rangers will visit Gregory A. Hogan Catholic School this Thursday, bringing their message about the importance of protecting bio-diversity and helping to create a more sustainable environment.

“We are pleased to have the Earth Rangers visit our school,” says Elena Pagotto, Principal of Gregory A. Hogan Catholic School. “Stewardship of God’s earth is an important part of the mission of Catholic education; and through this program the Earth Rangers are helping to create a generation of young environmentalists, who will help to protect endangered species and their habitats.”

Earth Rangers is a non-profit education and fundraising program, with a simple mission: To educate and inspire students about bio-diversity and provide tools to help protect animals at risk of extinction.

The Earth Rangers’ “Bring Back the Wild” program includes a school assembly and classroom presentations. The visit to Gregory A. Hogan will focus on four animals currently at risk of extinction: the American badger, the polar bear, the wood thrush and the Oregon spotted frog. The presentation also includes information about water conservation and pollution.
