BOARD OF TRUSTEES APPROVES CAPITAL PROJECTS AT THREE ST. CLAIR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

The Board of Trustees has awarded contracts for capital projects at three St. Clair Catholic schools. They are:

- \$307,998 for a partial roof replacement at Ursuline College Chatham
 Catholic Secondary School. The contract was awarded to Gillett Roofing
 Inc. of Kingsville. The project will include a partial roof removal and
 replacement of the gymnasium area and five classrooms in the Merici
 building.
- \$266,681 for a classroom and Learning Commons renovation at Holy
 Trinity Catholic School in Sarnia. The contract is awarded to Bill
 Hoekstra General Contracting of Sarnia. The project includes the
 reconfiguration of space to include one new classroom, one resource room
 and repurposing the existing library resource space into a new Learning
 Commons area.
- \$542,576 for a parking lot expansion at St. Matthew Catholic School in Sarnia. The contract is awarded to Wellington Builders Inc. of Forest. It includes an expansion of the parking lot, accessibility upgrades, a relocation of the existing basketball nets, fencing and landscaping.

All three projects require the approval of the Board of Trustees in accordance with the Board's purchasing policy.

"We are pleased to make these investments in our school communities, in keeping with the Board's mission to foster good stewardship of our resources and make wise use taxpayer dollars entrusted to our care," says Deb Crawford, Director of Education.
