- 2. Decide which colleges and programs you wish to apply to. You have up to a maximum of FIVE program choices, with no more than three choices at any one college. There is a \$95 non-refundable application processing fee.
 - a. Consult ontariocolleges.ca, counsellors and/or college personnel, attend College Open Houses.
 - b. Be sure you have checked the prerequisite courses for the desired program at <u>each</u> of your selected schools.
 - Obtain your Ontario Education Number found on your report card or timetable or from Student Services.

- 3. Log on to www.ontariocolleges.ca. Students are encouraged to review the "How to Apply" page located under **Applying** found at the top of the screen. A user guide can be downloaded for step-by-step instructions.
