French Immersion Program

- Students are required to take ten French Immersion Courses to earn a French Immersion Certificate.

Dual Credit Courses At St. Clair College

- Students must be in Grade 12
- Students must choose GWL30C (afternoon co-op)
- Students will go to St. Clair College one day/week to take the dual credit course
- List of dual credit courses is on Page 50 of the course calendar

Co-operative Education

- GWL302 (2 credits) - Morning or Afternoon Co-op.
- GWL304 (4 credits) - All-day Co-op
- Students must be 16 years of age to take co-op
- Students must complete an application form

Dual Credit Courses At Lambton College Sarnia

- Students must be in Grade 12
- Students must choose GWL30L (all-day co-op)
- Students will go to Lambton College one day/week to take the dual credit course
- List of dual credit courses is on Page 50 of the course calendar

Specialist High Skills Major

- Students must enter the program in Grade 11
- Students will take a bundle of nine Grade 11 and 12 credits
- Students must take two co-operative education credits
- Students will earn 3-4 compulsory certifications and 3 other certifications
- Students will receive a special red seal on their Ontario Secondary School Diplomas
