



RECOMMENDATIONS FROM S.E.A.C. FOR THE 2006-2007 SCHOOL YEAR

On May 15, 2006, SEAC made the following recommendations;

1. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board proceeds with the implementation phase of the recommendations from the Review of Programs and Services for Speech and Language.
2. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board continue the implementation phase of the recommendations from the Review of Programs and Services for Students with Giftedness.
3. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board distribute, in-service and implement the Home/School Communication protocol.
4. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board distribute, in-service and implement the protocol for Access and Consultation with Community Agencies.
5. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board continues to work in partnership with the local Learning Disabilities Associations to provide professional development opportunities for staff, parents and students.
6. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board develops and implements a protocol and guidelines outlining best practice in the area of Personal Care and the Ethics of Touch.
7. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board conducts a review of programs and services in the area of Deaf/Hard of Hearing.
8. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board develops and implements a professional development plan for Educational Assistants.
9. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board assist schools to promote, create and sustain inclusive environments.
10. That the St. Clair Catholic District School Board provide resources and professional development focused on effective programming for intermediate level students with a mild intellectual disability.
