2. St. Clair Catholic Strategic Plan

- > The St. Clair Catholic District School Board's last strategic plan was prepared in 2006.
- > The Strategic Planning session for the Board Advisory Council will be to review perspectives on living our faith, how the board can achieve success in educational achievement and innovation, perspective on delivering excellent and efficient service to rate payers.
- Handouts were provided to attendees on trends and what success would look like in 2016-2017 in each area of the board's mission statements and related goal statements. The information in the handout was gathered from a Strategic Planning meeting on February 11, 2014.
- Attendees discussed in groups and utilized polleverywhere.com to text in responses on their perspectives related to board mission and goal statements.
- > A web-based survey will be made available to further support parent input into the Board's Strategic Plan. It is hoped that by May or June 2014 the St. Clair Catholic Strategic Plan will be ready to communicate and be in place for September 2014.
