Brenda Courey opened the meeting at 7:04 p.m.

1. Opening Prayer

D. Parr, Director of Education

The meeting began with an opening prayer led by Dan Parr.

2. Approval of Meeting Notes from May 20, 2014

Tom Moore motioned to approve the meeting notes as presented. The motion was seconded by Phil Bedard. All attendees were in favour. Motion accepted.

3. Our Plan for Excellence in our Catholic Schools – 2014 and Beyond

D. Parr, Director of Education

- New Prayer cards with the Board's mission were presented. It was explained the cards will appear in our schools and at the Catholic Education Centre and will be used to open various meetings. A purpose of the new cards is to promote our Board Mission.
- The new booklet Lighting Our Way, Rejoicing in Our Journey was distributed. Mr. Parr explained this is the vision statement of our board, and he tied it in with our Mission statement. The Multi-year plan was highlighted which is found in the middle of the booklet. The start date of the Strategic Plan is September 2014.
- Time was given to review the strategic plan, and then it was discussed as a group. It was highlighted that goals are more easily manageable when broken into small pieces, such as in this plan.
- Short term targets have been set for 2014-15.

4. K-12 Catholic Learning Services Support Plan

- We have set short-term targets, as discussed in the previous presentation, and have developed this Support Plan to help keep us on track.
- > Mrs. Courey described benchmarks and targets that are tracked.
- It was explained that K-12 is a combination of Elementary, Secondary and Special Education departments.
- School Improvement Plans are used to determine what the most urgent needs for our students are, and goals are set based on these needs. Monitoring and check-points are in place to see how schools are doing with their goals. They are able to see evidence that this is working, and are able to make any necessary adjustments.
- An outline was given as to how the Board supports the School Improvement Plan process.
- The Board Improvement Plan and School Improvement Plans are all aligned with the Board Strategic Plan to ensure everyone is working towards the same goals.
- A sample of specialized projects the Board receives funding for from the ministry was shown to the committee. Examples included professional learning communities, framework for effective mathematics instruction, EQAO practice, primary reading, eLearning and Blended learning support among others.
- Framework for 21st Century learning was distributed to all in attendance and reviewed by the committee.

5. Growth Mindsets and How Parents Can Support Their Children
