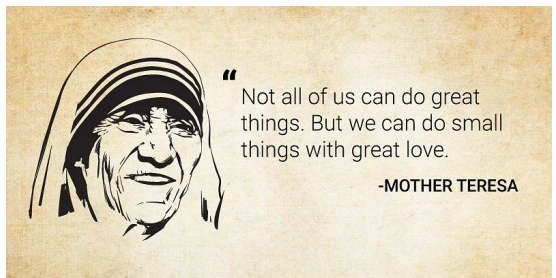

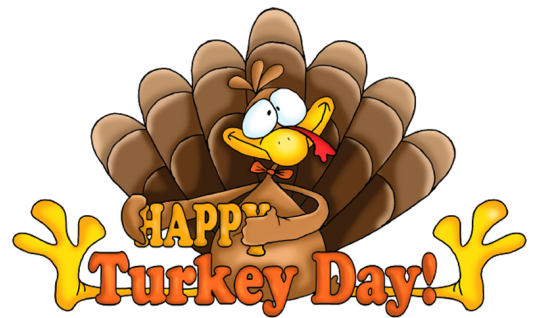
Paul Davis
