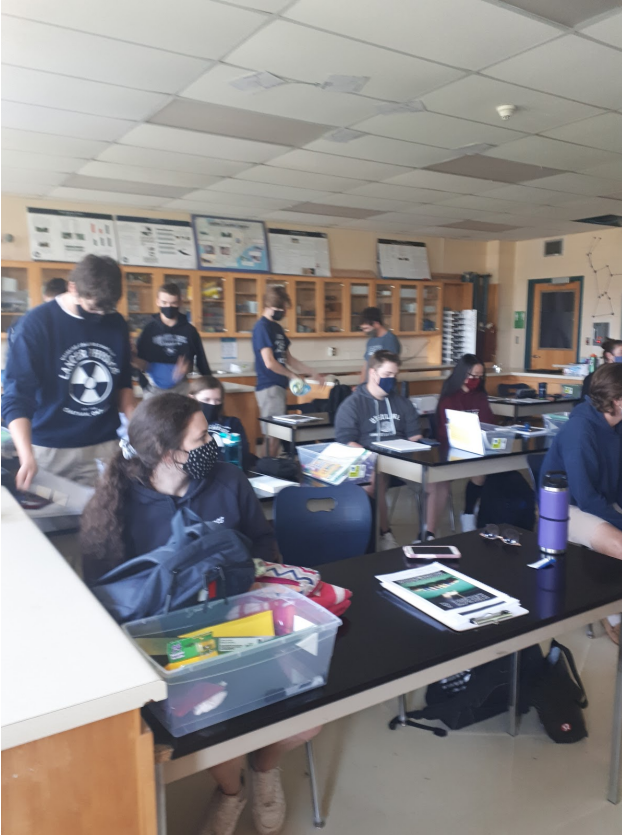

CHANGES!!!



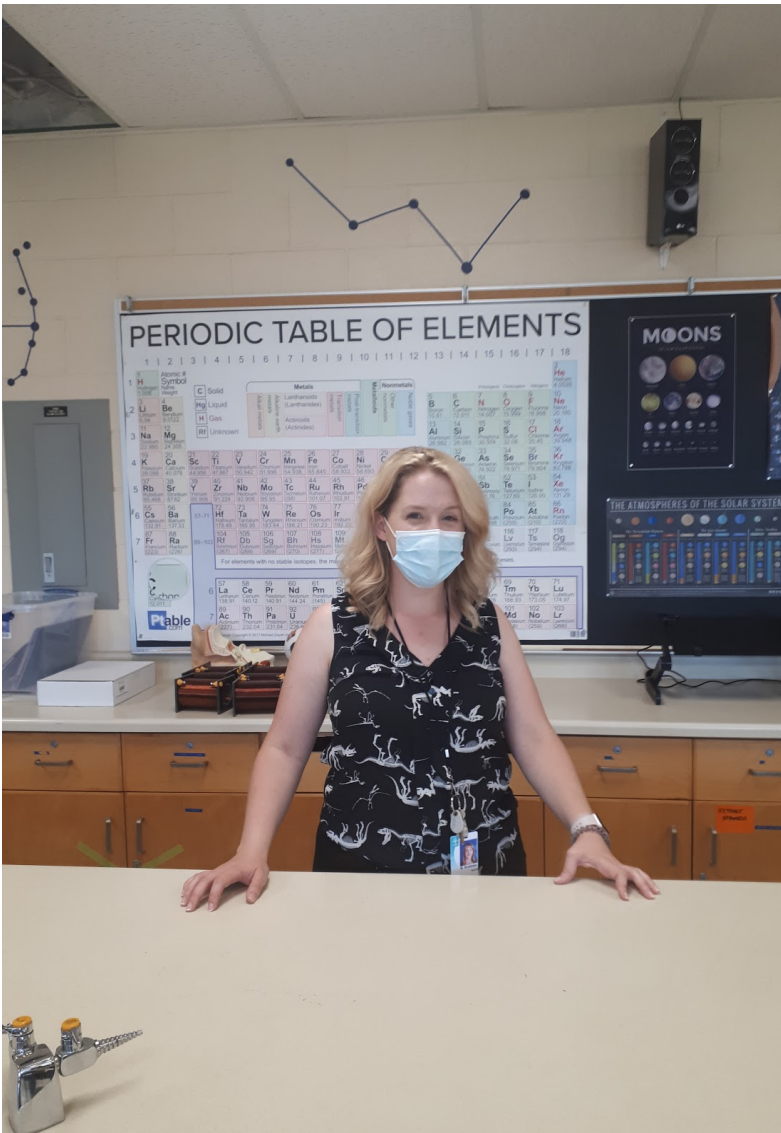
