Subject: Vice Principal Appointments – December 2022 and January 2023

## **Background**

Alishia Thompson returned from leave effective January 2023, which has resulted in some changes to our Vice Principal assignments. They are:

- Alishia will has returned to her role as Vice Principal, serving in a point-eight capacity at St. Anne Blenheim and point-two at St. Ursula.
- Angele Monette, who served as a point-six Acting VP at St. Anne Blenheim and point-four at St. Ursula, will continue in her role as VP at St. Ursula with a point-five assignment, and will take on point-five teaching duties at Monsignor Uyen Catholic School, where she will share the Grade 2/3 classroom with Mme. Joyce.

In addition, Jamie Majeski has decided to return to his first passion as a Catholic educator, which is helping students to become successful in math. Jamie will return to the classroom effective the beginning of Semester Two in February 2023.

## As a result:

- Jessica Verstraeten, who currently serves as Vice Principal at Gregory A. Hogan and St. Anne Sarnia, has been appointed Vice Principal at St. Patrick's Catholic High School.
- Kelly Tremblay, currently a classroom teacher at Sacred Heart Catholic School Sarnia, has been appointed to Vice Principal at St. Anne Sarnia and Gregory A. Hogan.

Both appointments are effective February 2023.

Finally, Rob Cicchelli has accepted my invitation to come out of retirement temporarily, to fill the Vice Principal role at Sacred Heart Catholic School Sarnia. We look forward to welcoming Rob back and drawing on his extensive experience and expertise in school administration. Rob will remain in the position for the remainder of the school year.

I want to thank Luana Sfalcin, who has filled the VP role at Sacred Heart since September. Luana's calm and confident nature and extensive knowledge are an asset to any school community.

We are indeed blessed at St. Clair Catholic to have a cadre of experienced and gifted school administrators, who are willing to pause their retirements for a season to assist the Board when needed.
