David Argenti and Carol Bryden presented to all in attendance. They shared their roles as trustees and discussed the background of Trustees and Catholic Education.

The new 5-year Strategic Plan was introduced by a short video shared by Deb Crawford, Director of Education. She then presented the board's new vision, mission, values and priorities.

# 5. Leveraging Technology to Support Higher Level Thinking Lisa Williams & Michael Giroux

Lisa and Mike shared examples of STEAM activities taking place in our classrooms. They discussed how STEAM activities fit into our Strategic Plan under Learning & Innovation. Examples were shared of students creating, using mathematics, and how students were engaged, innovative and not giving up on their tasks. Lisa and Mike discussed the transformation of school libraries into Collaborative Learning Spaces. These spaces still have their book collections, and now have moveable furniture, open spaces, green screens, and lego walls.

Materials used during the 2019 Summer Camp are part of STEAM kits being loaned out across all schools. 101 classrooms have now borrowed the kits over the past 8 weeks. The Curriculum Team tracks where these kits are going. Then they co-plan and follow up with teachers who are using them.

After School Tech Talks are taking place for teachers to learn more about coding, digital tools and math tech. SCCDSB has established partnerships with Public Libraries, Western Engineering and the Science Education Partnership.
