SUBJECT: Project Overview: Phase Four Renovations to Our Lady of Fatima Catholic School

BACKGROUND:

This project has been identified as a priority for 2019-20 at Our Lady of Fatima Catholic School in Chatham. It will consist of two main areas of work: Retrofit and Renovation, and Classroom Renewal.

The Retrofit and Renovation will consist of a learning commons renovation, relocation of the staff room and teacher's work room, a renovation to the main office and conference room, the introduction of a pod-style learning area in the south corridor, new dropdown stage and storage area in the gymnasium, new athletic flooring in the gymnasium, new change rooms, a new entrance hallway, and vestibules, and a new main entrance and canopy.

The Classroom Renewal will provide a refresh of the existing classrooms with the complete replacement of the flooring, new painting, new millwork, new tack boards and whiteboards, new classroom doors, and new window blinds.

Wilson Diaz Architects Incorporated of London has been engaged as the prime consultant for this project. Mr. Randy Wilson, Principal Architect for Wilson Diaz, has been licensed to practice architecture in Ontario for 29 years and is a member of the Ontario Association of Architects and the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada. Mr. Wilson's major area of practice is elementary and secondary school design, with over \$400,000,000 in school construction value. Mr. Wilson has completed projects for Western University, University of Guelph, the Government of Canada, the City of London, seven District School Boards, and many other organizations.
