- Scheduled chaplaincy visits with most of the elementary principals
- 2 visits so far; 12 visits scheduled for this week; 3 have not had a response from.
- Sent principals different questions in advance of my visit to give some thought to and touch base with their staff members about
- Learning a great deal that will inform her work and populating the Hub's Faith Support area
- Key areas
 - principals feel that the Faith Ambassadors would benefit from an update of what their role entails – gave suggestions for what it could include ("go to person" for other staff re: prayer tables, Mass/Service planning assistance
 - would like to set up visits in each school with faith ambassadors once she has met with the different principals and put some "next steps" in place; one principal will cover for faith ambassador for our visit, another will pay back prep time
 - Areas brought to her attention slide decks and prayer service outlines sent a slide deck template to all Ps & VPs today for Masses in ordinary time with suggestions for adjustments for a Liturgy of the Word service
 - Prayer tables suggestions for what to put on, reminder of liturgical colours,
 Feast Days, etc.
 - One staff retreat planned for next week; offering this to principals
 - request for planning sheets for Masses, services, Liturgy of the Word
 - Impromptu visit/chat with Fr. Brian Jane would like to go visit pastoral teams she has connected with principals; trying to strengthen partnership between parish and school and ease the work of both
- Kim shared the Religion and Family Life sections on the Staff learning hub
