Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program OYAP	Employers can have High School students for co-op placement while Student is still in school Student can be registered as an apprentice OYAP Students are exempt from ratio while on placement for co-op hours	
Summer Job Service through Employment Ontario	Employers can keep High School, College or University students employed through the summer Employers can receive a \$2.00/ hour wage subsidy if they qualify for the Summer Job Program	\$1280.00 potential
Employment Ontario	Employers who qualify can hire through the Employment Ontario program and may receive a wage incentive (candidates and employers must meet criteria to access). Employers can also have resumes screened for their particular jobs and postings can be done on the website	Speak to your local Employment Ontario Office for details
Apprenticeship Training Tax Credit	Employer can apply for this on their taxes based on the first 48 months of the apprenticeship wages. Has a potential of \$10,000.00 / year for the first 4 years	\$40,000.00 potential
Apprenticeship Employer Signing Bonus	Employer hires eligible employee. Employer received first installment after client is registered as an apprentice and the other installment 6 months later. Each for \$1000.00	\$2000.00
Apprenticeship Job Creation Tax Credit	Employers are eligible for a non-refundable tax credit up to \$2000.00 per year for the first two years of the apprenticeship (For Red Seal Trades Only)	\$4000.00 potential
Trades Person Tool Deduction	If employer is also a Journeyperson they are eligible for this deduction yearly as well	\$500.00 yearly
Co-operative Education Tax Credit	A refundable tax credit available to employers operating an incorporated businesses who hire students enrolled in a recognized Ontario university or college co-operative education program	\$3000.00 max / student / work term
Employer Completion Bonus	When an apprentice completes an apprenticeship program, receives Cert. of Apprenticeship and/or Cert. of Qualification. Employer is eligible for this bonus.	\$1000.00
Apprenticeship Network Recognition	Employers are nominated and recognized yearly for their support for the apprenticeship system in the Apprenticeship Network catchment area	
Minister's Apprenticeship Employer Award	Employers who offer apprenticeship are recognized Provincially

Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program OYAP	Gets an opportunity to start their apprenticeship as early as Grade 11 Can be signed as an apprentice while still in High School Min. of Training Colleges and Universities pays the \$40.00 registration fee	\$40.00
Employment Ontario - Summer Job Service	Students can find employers who are interested in taking on a High School, College or University Student	
Employment Ontario – Regular Program	Clients of Employment Ontario benefit from services like resume assistance, interview skills, etc Clients may also eligible for assistance with purchasing of tools, or other job related materials which will help them on the job.	See your local Employment Ontario Office for details
Apprenticeship Scholarship	Clients requiring upgrading to meet the academic eligibility requirements for apprenticeship training in their chosen trade.	\$1000.00
Trades Person Tool Deduction	Journeypersons and Apprentices can write off ½ of their yearly tool purchases which total up to \$1000.00 (write off \$500.00)	\$500.00 yearly
Apprenticeship Incentive Grant	This is a taxable cash grant which Apprentices apply for once they successfully complete Level I and Level II in school training (\$1000.00 for each of the two levels)	\$2000.00
Apprenticeship Completion Grant	For apprentices who complete their journeyperson training Apply for grant upon completion of final exam. Also for Non-Red Seal Trades	\$2000.00
Loan for Tools	Apprentices can take an interest free loan for tools once they are signed as an apprentice. Interest starts once apprentice has completed journeyperson exam or they leave the trade early	Amount varies based on sector
Apprenticeship Network Recognition	Local recognition for employers who offer apprenticeships. Employer and apprentice invited to event.
