ANNUAL KINGDOM ASSIGNMENT FUNDRAISING RESULTS TO BE ANNOUNCED NEXT TUESDAY AT UCC

St. Clair Catholic's Chatham-Kent elementary schools have wrapped up their fundraising projects for the annual *Kingdom Assignment*. Fundraising results will be announced next Tuesday at an assembly in the Ursuline College theatre.

"We are so proud of the work of our students and the support they give each and every year to the people of Chatham-Kent through the Kingdom Assignment," says Dan Parr, Director of Education.

"This is just one of the ways our students and staff live out their faith, as our school communities support those in our community who need our help."

In the annual *Kingdom Assignment*, St. Clair Catholic students support Chatham-Kent United Way through a variety of fundraising events. Thirty groups of students from Ursuline College and its elementary partner schools were given \$100 in seed money last fall, with three simple instructions: it's not their money, but God's; they must do something to further God's Kingdom outside the walls of the school; and, they must return and report what they did with the \$100.

From 2008 through 2014, St. Clair Catholic students have raised more than \$60,000 for Untied Way Chatham-Kent through the annual Kingdom Assignment.

Students will report their Kingdom Assignment projects and fundraising totals for 2015 at an assembly in the theatre at Ursuline College Chatham Catholic Secondary School, 85 Grand Ave., W. on Tuesday, January 27th at 10:00 a.m.
