ST. CLAIR CATHOLIC INVESTS MORE THAN \$3.6 MILLION IN SCHOOL IMPROVEMENTS ACROSS THE DISTRICT

The Board of Trustees has awarded contracts totalling more than \$3.6 million in school improvement work, which will be completed throughout the spring and over the summer months.

"Our strategic plan calls us to be wise stewards of the public resources with which we are entrusted," says Amy Janssens, Executive Superintendent – Corporate Services & Treasurer. "This significant investment in Catholic education across our district is in keeping with that commitment."

Highlights include:

- \$485,006 for a roof replacement at St. Peter Canisius, Watford. Work to be completed by Bullock & Sons Roofing, Sarnia.
- \$1,978,747 for roof replacements at St. Anne, Sarnia and St. Patrick's Catholic High School, Sarnia. Work to be completed by Bullock & Sons Roofing, Sarnia.
- \$836,665 for roof replacements at Good Shepherd, Thamesville, St. Joseph, Tilbury and St. Michael, Ridgetown. Work to be completed by Gillet Roofing Inc., Kingsville.
- \$327,453 for a Phase 3 lighting retrofit project at Holy Family, Wallaceburg, Holy Trinity, Sarnia, St. Elizabeth, Wallaceburg, St. Matthew, Sarnia and St. Patrick's Catholic High School, Sarnia. Work to be completed by Energy Network Services Inc., Richmond Hill. This is part of the Board's on-going five-year energy plan to reduce electrical consumption.

The projects are funded through the Board's annual School Condition Improvement allocation.
