



St. Clair Catholic Releases EQAO Results for 2024-2025

The Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO) has released the school, board and provincial results for the 2024-2025 Grade 3 and 6 assessments for reading, writing and mathematics, Grade 9 math and the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test.

"St. Clair Catholic students have made important achievement gains on EQAO assessments," says Lisa Demers, Director of Education. "The growth demonstrated that our work with students is making a difference and that our staff is committed to helping all students achieve."

In elementary, the most significant gains were in the Grade 3 and 6 reading results, with both showing a seven-percentage-point increase over the previous assessment. Grade 3 and 6 writing also showed growth. In secondary, Grade 9 math students scored eight percentage points higher than the previous year. On the OSSLT, 88% of first-time eligible students were successful, which is three percentage points higher than last year and the provincial average.

St. Clair Catholic students improved in seven out of the eight provincial assessment categories.

"These results align with the Board's strategic priorities and Student Achievement Plans, which are developed and reviewed annually," says Mrs. Demers. "We will review these results in detail as we develop our next multi-year strategic plan."

Grade 3 results for St. Clair Catholic Students:

- Reading: 77% (+7%)
- Writing: 65% (+2%)
- Math: 67% (+1%)

Grade 6 results for St. Clair Catholic Students:

- Reading: 85% (+7%)
- Writing: 84% (+4%)
- Math: 45% (-2%)

Grade 9 Mathematics results:

- Math: 58% (+8%)

Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) results:

- Literacy Test Success Rate: 88% (+3%)



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
