



Lambton Catholic Sports Council Track and Field Meet Set for June 4th at New St. Pat's Track

St. Clair Catholic is excited to announce the Lambton Catholic Sports Council track and field meet on Tuesday, June 4th, at the newly constructed track at St. Patrick's High School. The event will run from 10:00 am to 4:30 pm, featuring around 400 athletes from grades 3 to 8 across Sarnia-Lambton schools.

Track events will include sprints, long-distance runs, and relays, while field events will feature long jump, triple jump, ball throw for junior and intermediate athletes, and shot put for senior athletes.

The meet will begin with a 10:00 am opening ceremony, including a ribbon-cutting and a parade of athletes to celebrate the new St. Pat's track. Following this, the POEPEL (People of Every Possible Educational Level) races will include students with special education needs, highlighting SCCDSB's inclusive spirit.

St. Clair Catholic has also launched a 50/50 raffle to support the new track and field facility. This space will serve students and athletes throughout Sarnia-Lambton and will be accessible to the wider community and people of all abilities.
