



Huron Lakers Donate \$5,000 to Support OFSAA Tournament at St. Patrick's

The Huron Lakers Basketball Organization has donated \$5,000 to support the upcoming OFSAA (Ontario Federation of School Athletic Associations) senior girls' basketball tournament, which will be hosted by St. Patrick's Catholic High School, Sarnia.

About 200 athletes from 16 secondary schools across the province will participate in the tournament in November. The funds will help to pay for referees for the event and the traditional semi-formal banquet, which is attended by all team members and coaches.
