# **CYCLONE AID**

Join us this Saturday, April 1st for the 16th annual Cyclone Aid food drive!

Beginning at 8:30am, over 300 Fighting Irish volunteers (including staff, students, families and community partners) will mobilize to canvass every house in Sarnia, Point Edward and Bright's Grove fornon-perishable food items. In all, we aim to collect upwards of 25 000 pounds of food for The Inn of the Good Shepherd.

To make our goal a reality, however, we need your help:

First, we need as many high school students as possible to sign-up as canvassers. Students can sign-up outside the cafeteria during lunches this week. They can sign-up as teams. They can also sign up as individuals and be placed on a team. Every canvasser helps!

Second, we need as many drivers as possible. Driver can sign up by emailing Chaplain Joseph Palko (<a href="mailto:joseph.palko@sccdsb.net">joseph.palko@sccdsb.net</a>). If you already have students to canvass with you, please indicate who they are in your email. If you do not already have students, a team will be provided for you on Saturday.

All volunteers are asked to be at St. Patrick High School by 8:30am to receive driving and dropoff instructions. Following the event, volunteers are invited back to St. Pat's for a free breakfast put on by the Catholic Women's League.

Finally, Holy Mass will be celebrated in our school chapel at 7:30am in support of our food drive. All are warmly welcomed to join us for this time of prayer.
