Art Christmas Memorial Bursary – 2 @ \$500

- Outstanding community service
- Aimed at a field in music as a major area of study
- Must have attended AMSS, LCCVI, NCIVS, NLSS or GLSS

Action: Complete page 1
Essay—summary indicating interest in a career in the arts and plans to achieve this, as well as proof of outstanding community involvement

Canadian Federation of University Women Sarnia – M. Scott Mays Award – 3 @ \$100

- Best six university entrance courses. Must include one of : English, Math or French.
- Maximum of 2 winners from one school.

Action: Based on aggregate. No application required. Automatic consideration.

Dr. A.R. Wells Scholarship – University - \$100 and College - \$50

- Best six university entrance courses
- Son/daughter of a present employee, retiree, or deceased former employee of the Lambton-Kent District School Board (Lambton County area)

Action: Complete pages 1 & 2 Section A

I.O.D.E. Scholarships – University and College – Several at \$500

- Best six university or college entrance courses (Based on aggregate)
- Recipient must not have received greater than \$1,000 in other awards (Entrance scholarships excluded)

Action: Complete page 1. Automatic consideration.

Jeane Ewing Martin Scholarship = University Approximately \$4,000

- Highest average in two Grade 12 University level Mathematics courses
- Students from NCIVS and GLSS may only apply

Action: Complete Page 1

Jeane Houghton Memorial Award - \$50

- Enrolled in Canadian University Music Program

Action: Complete page 1, indicating enrollment in post-secondary music program

Sarnia-Lambton Real Estate Scholarship - \$2,000 ** Open to Out of Country Studies

- Best six senior courses with minimum of 75% average
- Son/daughter/dependent/grandchild of living or deceased Broker, Sales Rep or Assoc. Member of the Sarnia-Lambton Real Estate Board

Action: Complete pages 1 & 2 Section B

William & Beatrice Kent Educational Award – amount determined in June each year

The award will be issued to a student entering their first year of university or college and who demonstrates financial need and who has not benefitted from other large awards.

- Firstly, young people entering university or college in Canada, who, at the time of entrance are active members of the parish of All Saints', Sarnia or Corunna, and have achieved a high school graduation average not less than 78%.
- Secondly, any other young attending AMSS, GLSS or NCIVS who have a high school graduation average of not less than 78%.
