Course selections should be submitted in myBlueprint by Friday, March 7 at noon. Approving Your Student's Course Selections

In myBlueprint, once students submit their courses they are prompted with a Send Approval Email option. Once clicked, a parent or guardian's email address can be added. The parent/guardian then receives a course selection approval request email, including the details of their student's course selections. Please ensure you:

- Receive the Course Selection Approval email
- Carefully review the courses – and level of study – that your student has selected
- Select either “Approve Course Selections” or “Reject Request”

Note: The last day for students to submit their course selections is **Friday, March 7 (by noon)**.
The last day for parents/guardians to approve course selections is **Friday, March 21 (by noon)**.
