



18 Compulsory Credits 12 Optional Credits 40 Hours of Community Service The Provincial Literacy Requirement

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Notes:

- 1. Community Service Hours must be completed and submitted by February 2, 2018
- 2. Repeated courses do no count as additional credits
- **3.** University-bound students are required to take a minimum of six 4U or 4M courses. Please check program pre-requisites.
- **4.** SHSM students should check if they have met course, co-op and certification requirements.
