Audition Details:

- Our audition sign up will open during the first week of school. Listen to morning announcements at UCC and watch our [social media] for instructions and details. We will hold auditions on September 12, 13, and 14th from 2:30-4:15. (Late buses should be running by this time.)
- Be punctual on audition day! Come ready to move, and sing. We will help with your prepared audition song and teach you a movement sequence. You will have the opportunity to practice and then show us what you have learned.
- Results from the first round of auditions will be posted by Friday, September 15th. If you are called back for a second audition you will be given instructions regarding which character part to prepare for. See details below about songs and scene work connected to each character.

How to prepare for the audition:

- Get to know the storyline and the characters by reading the book, watching the movie(s), and listening to the music. <u>Click here</u> to read about some of our featured characters.

- Directors ALWAYS Look for...
 - Team Players: people who listen and support their fellow performers
 - Poise & Personality: confident, relaxed and energetic performers
 - Good Diction & Projection: speaking loudly, clearly, and slowly enough to prounounce all the sounds in each word
 - Understanding: performers who "get" what they are reading
 - Expression: performers must share their feelings and emotions with the audience while reading, dancing or singing
 - Vulnerability: allowing your sensitive side to show
 - Whole-hearted Acting: using everything you've got face, voice and entire body
 - Flexibility: being able to make changes if asked
 - Dedication: Students who can really commit to the show.
