Dear Parents/Guardians:

This letter is notification of an additional confirmed case of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) in your school community. Chatham-Kent Public Health has completed the necessary contact tracing and has determined that there is no impact to the school and is not dismissing any additional students or staff as a result of this confirmed case.

As requested prior to the start of the school year, please continue to monitor your child for symptoms of COVID-19. If your child is ill, please keep them at home and call your health care provider or local health unit.

People with COVID-19 may have little to no symptoms; some symptoms are similar to the common cold or flu. Symptoms range from mild – like the flu and other common respiratory infections – to severe. The most common symptoms include:

- fever
- cough
- difficulty breathing
- change in smell or taste

The coronavirus spreads from close contact with the respiratory droplets of a person infected with COVID-19. Respiratory droplets can include coughing, sneezing, talking and normal breathing. It is possible for a person to get COVID-19 by touching surfaces that have the virus on it and then touching their mouth, nose, or eyes.
