## Principal Report

- 6.1 Returning to School Presentation (due to time restrictions no presentation was shared)
- 6.2 Health and Safety Protocols: Ray spoke to the protocols that continue to be in place as we return

to face to face learning.

- Frequent hand washing / sanitizing
- Signage / arrows in hallways to promote physical distancing (traffic flow)
- Mandatory masks (staff and students) when indoors and in bus zones
- Tracking contact tracing
- Custodial staff are cleaning high touch points twice a day
- Modified Semester 2 classes and lunches with outside access
- Outdoor breaks encouraged
- Extra Curricular opportunities are starting to return to the school however safety protocols will be expected there as well.
- 6.3 Covid Related Information: Ray shared information pertinent to the safe operations of schools.
  - It is imperative that families and staff use the Ontario Self Assessment Tool prior to attending each day.
  - Isolation areas are used if a student becomes ill throughout the day, until a family member can pick them up. Approximately 3 students per day. One confirmed positive case this year.
  - Additional staff supervisors added to assist with covid protocol.
  - A parent asked a question about large class sizes and maximizing physical distancing. Ray
    responded by sharing there is a discrepancy between some class sizes. He shared excess
    furniture has been removed from classes and there is no face to face classroom set up. Students
    can be elbow to elbow. Ideally, large class size could be moved to the largest rooms but ensuring
    students follow safety protocols is still the best way to mitigate risks.
  - A parent asked a question about isolation and if students have other medical conditions that
    appear to be similar to covid symptoms do they still need to isolate. Ray shared that pre existing
    conditions could be considered as possible reduced isolation periods. Discussions should be
    shared with your child's Vice Principal.
