7.0 Principal Report

- Quad 1 / Quad 2 / Quad 3 UCC students attended Virtual High School.
- UCC will not open the opportunity for changes to virtual in Quad 4 (scheduling conflicts)
- Quad 2 closed the quad and semester with four weeks of virtual learning
- Return to face to face learning was welcomed and seamless on Monday Feb. 8th. The students and staff are happy to be back at school, although it is different than a year ago. The positive relationships our educators create with the students is crucial to their well being and health.
- New enhanced safety protocols in place:
 - Staff Self Assessment Screening and Verification daily prior to entry
 - Student Self Assessment verified by classroom teacher
 - Wearing of masks outdoors when within 2 meters of others
 - Safety glasses / goggles / face shields by staff indoors
 - Symptomatic staff and students require 10 day isolation or a medical practitioner identifying an alternative diagnosis or negative covid test.
 - Symptomatic persons impact entire household to self isolate
 - All questions regarding isolation are directed to public health.
- Library Access for Staff and Students has been approved again with enhanced safety protocols. Staff and students will be able to have limited access to the library.
- Student Council Activities Wacky Wednesday, Dress Down Days and School Kahoots.
- Dress down day are \$10 via cash online for the duration of the year Charitable donations support local agencies (Feb Women's Shelter)
- Chaplaincy Activities Liturgy of the Word Virtual Ash Wednesday Service, Virtual Easter Prayer service is presentation from Brother Guy on Faith and Science
- Seeking parent consent for photos and posting virtual events / images inter school and on website (internet)
- Seeking parent feedback on quad model demands on students / families. Pleases email Ray with any questions or concerns you may have.

8.0 Covid Related Updates:

- Update on Positive Cases and Isolation two positive cases since our return to learning on Feb 8. Both cases the students never attended school so there were NO implications for students in the school.
- Over two and a half weeks, five students have been sent home with symptoms. All have had improvement in symptoms and eligible to return (however effective Friday Feb 19 new isolation expectations.
- UCC takes direction from Public Health and continues to practice enhanced safety protocols throughout the school.
- Enhanced Safety Protocol Expectations Frequent hand washing / sanitizing, cleaning high touch points twice a day, promoting physical distancing, mandatory masks indoors and outside when less than 2 meters separation (staff wearing face shields or glasses) and in the bus loading zones.
- It is imperative that families and staff use the Ontario Self-Assessment Tool prior to attending each day.
- Daily Ministry Reporting continues with the number of students in attendance and number of illnesses.
