This Valuation Instrument has been created by the senior administration of the St. Clair Catholic District School Board, in keeping with guidelines provided by the Ministry of Education. It is to be used to guide your thinking in determining the value of each school.

The St. Clair Catholic District School Board is proud of all of its schools. Each is a vibrant community, populated by staff and students who care about the faith, learning and each other; yet, the reality of declining enrollment forces us to make some difficult choices.

This Valuation Instrument is designed to assist you as a member of the Accommodation Review Committee, as you give due consideration to the various components of each school and the value it gives to the student, the board, the community and the local economy. You will note that the greatest weight is given to the value of the school relative to the student, which stresses importance of viewing the school from this perspective. While this checklist attempts to capture much of what a school offers in an objective way, it is impossible to list everything. Therefore, while it will figure prominently in your decisions around ranking the schools, it is not intended to be the sole source of information.

As you tour through the schools and listen to presentations, please refer to this valuation instrument. It is also suggested that you take notes during the tour.
