### ***“BIG HEARTS – BIG TRUCK” LENTEN COLLECTION FOR CHATHAM’S OUTREACH FOR HUNGER FOOD BANK***

Popular U.S. Monster Jam tour driver Joe Sylvester will be bringing his 10,000 pound “Bad Habit” Monster Truck to St. Ursula Catholic School in Chatham, as part of a Lenten fundraiser, which the school and parish are jointly organizing to assist Chatham-Kent’s Outreach for Hunger.

The students, staff and families of both the school and St. Ursula’s Catholic Church, will welcome Sylvester and his “Bad Habit” Monster Truck and Team to Chatham on **Thursday, April 7<sup>th</sup>** during the event, which is being called “*Big Hearts – Big Truck.*”

The St. Ursula Catholic School Do the Right Thing Student Outreach Committee will be accepting non-perishable donations all week and are inviting all members of our community, who wish to see a really “big truck” to also bring a really “big heart” in the form of non-perishable food items.

Sylvester is the youngest owner/driver on the Monster Jam circuit and is also the world record holder for the longest jump in a monster truck. He is currently competing in shows across the United States and will stop in Chatham on his way to scheduled events in Montreal and Ottawa.

The “Bad Habit” Monster Truck will be on display and Sylvester will be available for pictures and autographs on **Thursday, April 7, 2011 from 1:30 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. and again from 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.** in the parking lot adjacent to the school and the church, at the corner of Lacroix and Tweedsmuir.
